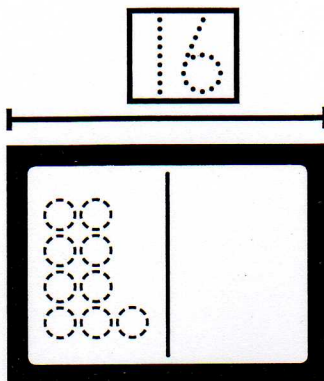

Write a subtraction sentence.

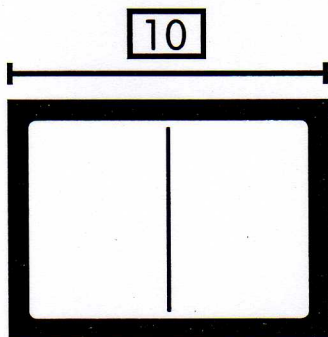
1. Pete has 16 stickers. He uses 9 of them. How many stickers does he have left?

2. Hong has 10 stamps. She gives 6 stamps to Joe. How many stamps does she have left?



4 stamps

6 stamps

5 stamps

7 stamps

3. Reasonableness James has 12 rocks. He puts 7 rocks in Maria's garden. Which subtraction sentence tells how many rocks he has left?

$7 - 2 = 5$

$12 - 5 = 7$

$7 - 4 = 3$

$12 - 7 = 5$
