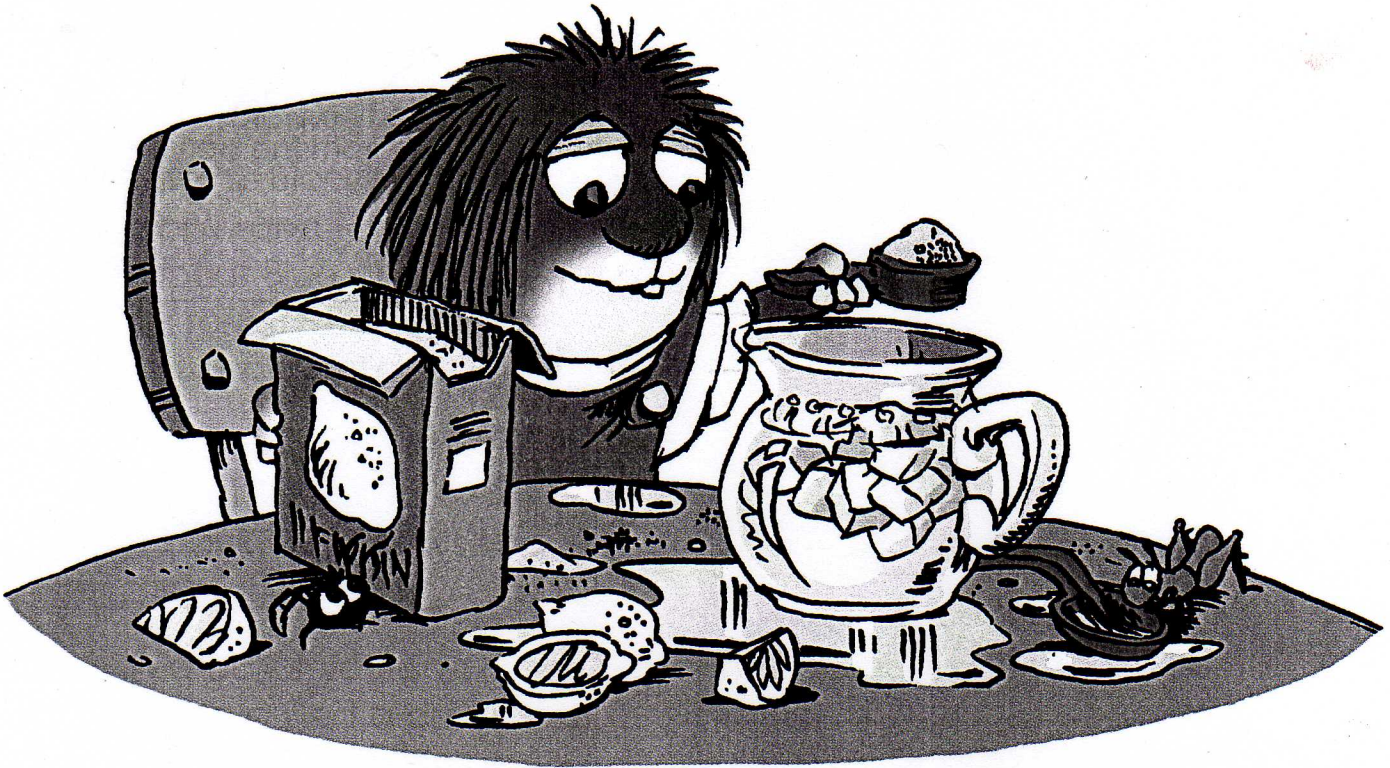


Gabby's Idea
